

## Quilt Show Updates for 2009

With the opening of the 2009 quilt show we will be celebrating our 25th quilt show in Council. Our 2009 theme "Hearts and Hands, Thimbles and Threads: 25 years of Quilting" is designed to reflect the past 25 years. In order to qualify theme entries must contain all four elements of the theme; Hands, Hearts, Thimbles, and Threads. Entries can use any technique you like. Each entry **MUST** include a **brief paragraph** explaining your entry. Entries cannot have a perimeter larger than 180" total.

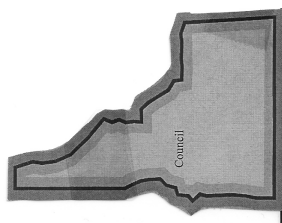
We will be accepting quilts on June 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> at the Council Elementary School. Your completed entry form must arrive before May 29th. These can be mailed or emailed. Shipping information is listed under the rules.

Marilyn's Pickets & Patchworks of Nyssa, Oregon will be here vending on June 13th and June 14th.

Our luncheon will be held on June 13th this year at the Council Senior Center. Lisa Bongean, this years speaker, is an award winning quilter, teacher, designer and quilt shop owner who has loved quilting since she began in 1996. Her primary focus is to spread her love of quilting and the pride of accomplishment for working hard & trying new techniques. Lisa is an experienced teacher and the owner of Primitive Gatherings, a quilt shop that is in Menasha, WI. Her shop features her line of hand dyed wools, homespun, reproduction and designer fabrics that carry the same warm feeling as the shop. Lisa wants to share as many skills as possible with her students and quilting friends; pinning, piecing, trimming, perfect points, time savers, etc. "The feeling is indescribable when I've inspired a quilter with one of my designs and it overwhelms me to see their finished projects". 4. A sales desk for folded quilts, arts and crafts is available. Consignments are not voted on.
5. Each quilt must have its OWN entry form AND label sewn or pinned.

**All decisions are final. Winners will be announced on July 6, 2009**

**THEME**

One award given for this year's theme category, "Hearts & Hands Thimbles and Threads: 25 Years of Quilting". Total circumference must not exceed 180 inches, (ex. 45"X45") Over sized entries will not be accepted as a theme entry. A brief paragraph describing why your entry fits the category must be included. Entries must contain all four elements of the theme, Hearts, Hands, Thimbles, and Threads.  
Award: Ribbon and \$100.00
